Clearing Cookies and Cache – Internet Explorer

Internet Explorer:
Click on Tools
Select Internet Options
On the General Tab locate Browsing History and select Delete
Select the options of Temporary Internet Files and Cookies
Hit Delete
Once your history has been cleared, log out of RDN.
Manually type www.recoverydatabase.net in to your address bar and hit go
Select Login to RDN for our subscribers
Select your RDN login and login to RDN

Clearing Cookies and Cache – Mozilla Firefox

Mozilla:
Click on Tools
Select Options
Click Privacy Tab
Locate the history section and click clear your recent history
Select Everything for Time range to clear
Below details select Cookies, Cache, and Active Logins
Press Clear Now
Once your history has been cleared, log out of RDN.
Manually type www.recoverydatabase.net in to your address bar and hit go
Select Login to RDN for our subscribers
Select your RDN login and log in to RDN



Clearing Cookies and Cache – Google Chrome

Chrome:

Click the Chrome menu on the browser toolbar.

Select Tools.

Select Clear browsing data.

In the dialog that appears, select the check boxes for the types of information that you want to remove.

Use the menu at the top to select the amount of data that you want to delete. Select beginning of time to delete everything.

Click Clear browsing data.

Once your history has been cleared, log out of RDN.

Manually type www.recoverydatabase.net in to your address bar and hit go

Select Login to RDN for our subscribers

Select your RDN login and log in to RDN



Clearing Cookies and Cache – Safari

Safari:

On your browser, go to Safari.

Under safari click on empty cache.

You will then be asked if your sure you want to empty the cache, simply click empty.

Now go back to your browser, and go to safari.

Under safari click on preferences.

From the security dialog box, click bookmarks, then click show cookies.

Now from the cookies dialog box, click remove all, then click done.

Once your history has been cleared, log out of RDN.

Manually type www.recoverydatabase.net in to your address bar and hit go

Select Login to RDN for our subscribers

Select your RDN login and log in to RDN
